Customer challenges and requirements

The initial goal was to simplify the day-to-day use of printing for employees, as well as the ability to submit and retrieve documents from any location and implementing a code-protected print security insuring confidentiality.

Reducing the work load for the IT team when implementing, deploying and monitoring the overall solution was also an important criterion.

In addition, a priority for Union d'Experts is limiting our environmental impact, which is enabled by the ability to cancel printouts made by mistake, limiting our wastage.



The solution

Canon FacSimilé Ouest suggested the uniFLOW Online serverless solution to manage the entire fleet of printing devices. To facilitate deployment, the self-registration functionality is used so that users are autonomous in accessing the uniFLOW Online portal, retrieving their account information and printing easily. In addition, the default setting of black and white printing encourages users to print responsibly. Posters above the MFPs provide a visual demonstration of how to retrieve documents, making it easy for users to get started without any special training. The scanning capability has also been chosen to complement the user experience.
