



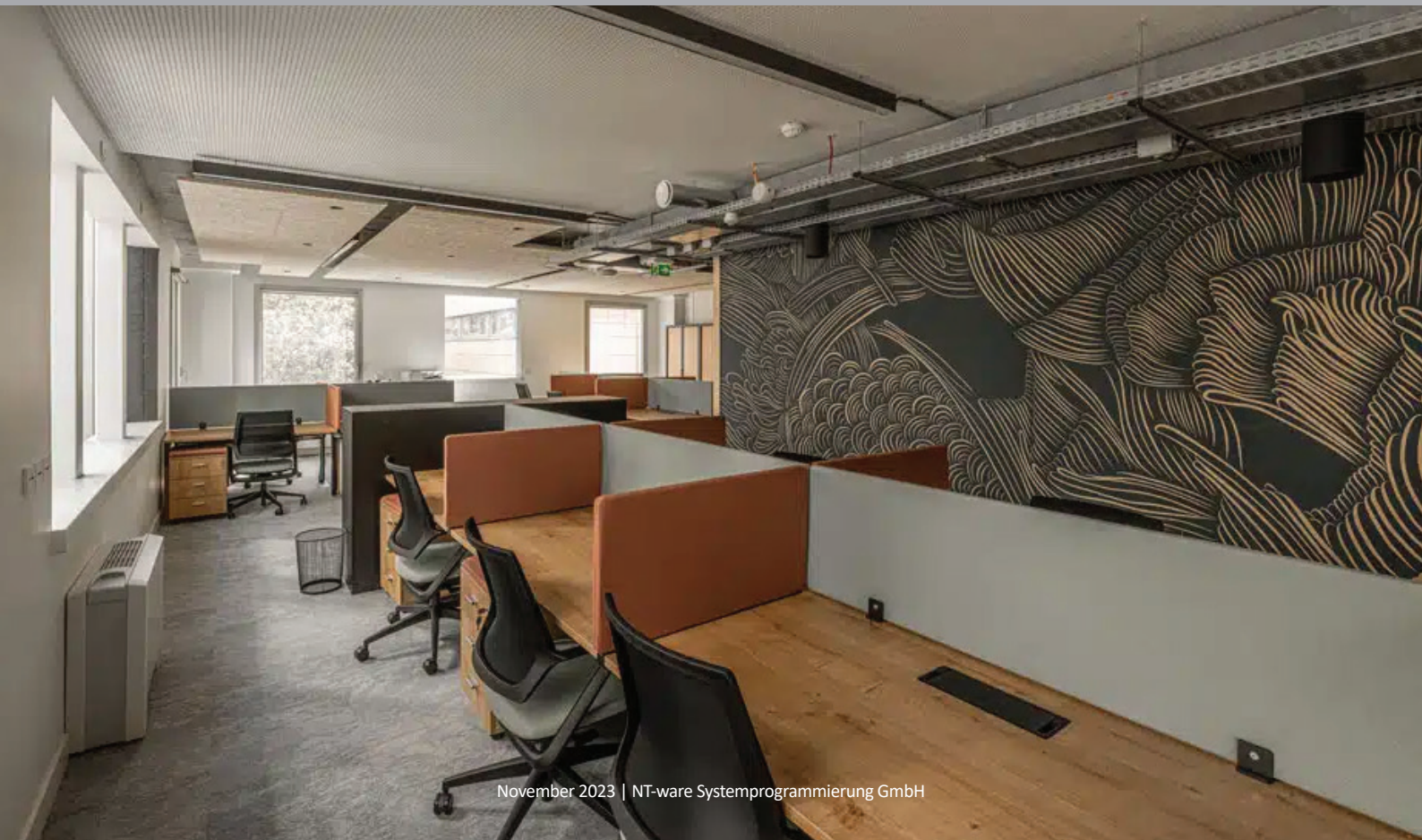

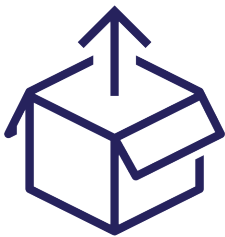

Customer challenges and requirements

■ ■ Following the Collège's rapid expansion in 2019, the IT department decided to decommission all servers at its various sites, including print servers, to increase productivity and reduce costs. Initially, each workstation was prepared with a site-specific print driver but, with increasing nomadism and teachers travelling, the requirement to add missing print queues hugely increased the IT department's workload. Having ruled out the Microsoft Universal Print proposal - too expensive - and the Xerox Workplace Cloud solution - too limited - Collège de Paris turned to Canon.



The solution

■ ■ In 2022, Canon implemented the uniFLOW Online cloud service, allowing administrators and teachers to submit print jobs via the uniFLOW Smart Client for secure printing on Canon devices and direct printing for the remaining non-Canon devices, without having to worry about the site or print drivers. Students use the uniFLOW Online's web interface to submit their work. Since the start of the new academic year, one of the institutions has introduced budget management with two wallets for students; one recharged by Collège de Paris and the other via PayPal by each student.

Benefits

■ ■ Since its implementation, uniFLOW Online has reduced printing costs at Collège de Paris by 20% thanks to elimination of orphan printing, reduction in personal printing and by billing a proportion of students' printing through the recharging of budgets. In addition, simplification of workstation preparation and a fall in calls related to the installation of printer drivers has meant the IT department saves time which can now be allocated to more rewarding projects e.g. integration of new establishments or setting up a new campus. Finally, users are delighted with the quality and functionality of the print service.
