Customer challenges and requirements

The customer aimed to modernize their printing infrastructure by replacing outdated Xerox machines with a secure, cloud-integrated solution supporting MFPs. Persistent issues with a server-based print management solution, such as unreliable printing, poor authentication, and Chromebook incompatibility, hindered productivity. Key requirements included secure, remote printing across Chromebook, macOS, and Windows; cloud integration for scalability and centralized management; and enhanced document security via card and PIN authentication. The new solution needed to improve user experience and ensure seamless, secure access from any device or location while integrating into their existing cloud services.



The solution

To modernize its printing infrastructure, the customer replaced outdated Xerox devices and a problematic third-party, server-based print management setup with uniFLOW Online, a secure, cloud-native solution. The platform supports printing and scanning across Chromebook, macOS, and Windows, with card and PIN authentication. Key features include "Scan to Myself", Chromebook compatibility via the uniFLOW Chrome app, and centralized management through a web interface. The cloud-based system eliminates the need for on-premise servers, reducing IT complexity and maintenance. This implementation ensures secure, scalable, and user-friendly printing across all devices and locations.
